3. A Chapter of the Provincial Priory of Malta will be opened.
4. Silence (*11:00a.m.*) will be observed in memory of those who lost their lives in defence of our Country in the two World Wars and other conflicts around the World.
5. The previous minutes of the meeting of the Chapter of Provincial Priory of Malta, held at Masonic Hall, Llanelli on Saturday 11th November 2017 will be offered for confirmation.
6. The Provincial Vice-Chancellor will call the Muster Roll of the Provincial Priory of Malta Officers.
7. The Provincial Vice Chancellor will read the Fire Notice.
8. The Provincial Vice-Chancellor will call the Muster Roll of Priorities of Malta in the Province.
9. The eligible Candidates will be installed as Knights of St. Paul.
10. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will appoint and invest the Officers of Provincial Priory of Malta for the year 2018–2019.
11. The Knights of St. Paul will be admitted to the Order of St. John of Jerusalem, Palestine, Rhodes and Malta.
